



Lufkin Little League All-Star Selection Process

All-Star Manager Selection:

Any coach who participated in an official capacity in the regular season as a head coach or assistant coach can be nominated (or nominate themselves) to be considered as the manager of the division's All-Star Team. The Lufkin Little League Board will then select a manager for each age division's All-Star team from the list of nominated candidates. As part of the selection process, the board may conduct interviews with coaches, evaluate their past conduct and behavior, and consider coaching experience before making a final selection. According to LL rules, the coach must have participated in the current season as either a head coach or assistant coach in their respective age group during the regular season. If no eligible coach is available, the board will seek approval from Little League for an exception. The selected All-Star manager will then select his two assistant coaches from the list of league coaches.

Important Note! The final regular-season standings have no bearing on which coach is selected to lead each All-Star team.

Player Vote:

Lufkin Parks and Recreation will set up at Morris Frank Park and allow every player to vote for the best player from their age division whom they believe should be on the All-Star team. Once all the votes have been cast, the ballots will be counted by employees of Lufkin Parks and Recreation, along with at least one board member. The player receiving the most votes will be automatically placed on their respective All-Star Team. Coaches and parents are not allowed to influence the player's vote. The Little League Baseball Board reserves the right to review all voting results and disqualify any outcome if there is reasonable suspicion of tampering, or any other irregularity that compromises the integrity of the process.

Coaches Vote:

Lufkin Parks and Recreation will email a ballot to each Head Coach and Assistant Coach who participated in an official capacity during the regular season, including every player in their age division. The player who was selected by their peers will be removed from the coaches' ballot since they are already on the team. Once coaches receive the ballot via email or paper from Lufkin Parks and Recreation, they will be given the opportunity to vote for a minimum of 11 players unless decided otherwise by the All-Star Manager. Ballots must be turned in via email or in person at Lufkin Parks and Recreation prior to the deadline. All coaches' votes will then be counted by Lufkin Parks and Recreation employees and witnessed by at least two board members. If the final spot(s) for the team end up in a voting tie, only the appointed manager (Head Coach) will be able to break such a tie.
